


BELLYBOARD BUILT FEBRUARY 1958

● Leigh Tingle takes the shorebreak at Boomer on a Belly Board. Tingle is a former N.S.W. surfer and is believed to be the first to surf the treacherous Voo Doo Bay on a Belly Board.

BUILT FROM OFFCUTS OF BALSA WOOD AND COATED WITH FIBREGLASS. IT ORIGINALLY HAD TWO PLYWOOD FINS, HENCE THE BLACK MARKS ON THE SURFACE DUE TO THE NAILS ROTTING IN SEA WATER. THESE WERE REPLACED WITH FIBREGLASS.

Width at 384mm from front = 537mm

Width at 614mm from rear = 531mm

Width at 307mm from rear = 525mm

Depth at 384mm from front = 48mm

Depth at end = 16mm

Height of handle = 39mm and raked in at front

Handle located 250mm from front

Fins = 128mm x 102mm
